____ + Who ?

Nicolas Heredia and La Vaste Entreprise develop different projects in theatres, contemporary art centers or in public spaces, mixing visual arts and performing arts. They compose, year after year, a collection of pieces always linked to each other, and most of the time focusing on ordinary events – that might somehow become poetic. In recent years, they have notably presented in many places in France "Visite de Groupe", "L'Origine du monde (46x55)", "À ne pas rater", "L'Instant T." or "La Fondation du Rien".

____ What ?

Available in several languages (french/english/spanish), the new hybrid and playful creation by La Vaste Entreprise, La Fondation du Rien, is a "rich program of canceled activities": its website offers you a large catalog of activities, to which you can register with full trust, since they will be ultimately canceled – allowing you, instead, to finally enjoy an unexpected and delightfull chunk of free time. So all you have to do is register: you will receive your pdf ticket, then when the day comes, an email announcing the cancellation of your activity.

Then it's up to you: you're free to do whatever you want with this graciously generated moment.

You can then write to the Foundation to tell about your experience: your testimony will then be part of the piece – whether you brilliantly managed to do nothing or whether your attempt to take advantage of this moment which was offered to you was ended in dismal failure.

Diverting the vocabulary of marketing to tickle a little our difficulty in dealing with the permanent overflow of various injunctions, the Foundation deploys a writing style of the "surprise bundle", in the form of multiple tools/performances: promotional stands in public spaces, leafleting campaigns, emails to "evaluate your customer experience" or to "refer a friend", hotline, conference performed by its author, etc.

With its very simple poetic idea, the dream of La Fondation du Rien is to brilliantly achieve the idiotic and magnificent paradox of developing the use of its services all over the world.

NICOLAS HEREDIA



+ Author, director, scenographer and actor, Nicolas Heredia has been developing the La Vaste Entreprise project since 2007, where his theatrical work and his practice of visual arts come together.

He designed and performed in 2009 *La Mastication des morts (oratorio-solo)* by Patrick Kermann, and *L'Augmentation (épopée immobile)* by Georges Perec.

From 2013, writing took a more important place: he created *Faux-plafond (ciel variable)*, with six actors from La Bulle bleue, a professional company of actors with mental or psychological disabilities.

In 2014 he wrote and directed *N'attrape pas froid (ma grand-mère)*, from saved answering machine messages, filmed images, texts. Then La Vaste Entreprise publishes a book which extends the show (images and texts).

In 2016, he wrote and created for public spaces and art centers *Visite de Groupe*, a visit which aims to visit the group of visitors itself, "audio-guided performance for a synthetic voice and a group of people" (Carré d'Art – contemporary art museum in Nîmes, La Panacée – contemporary art center in Montpellier, Scène nationale d'Albi, Scène nationale de Narbonne, Louvre-Lens Museum...).

In 2018, he wrote and performed *L'Origine du monde (46x55)*, theatrical performance taking as its starting point a copy of Courbet's painting purchased in a flea market (Carré d'Art – contemporary art museum in Nîmes, Musée Fabre – fine arts museum in Montpellier, La Manufacture – Avignon, NEST CDN Thionville, MAMC+ – contemporary art museum in Saint-Etienne...)

In 2021, he wrote and performed À *ne pas rater* a "show that aims to explore everything you miss elsewhere while you attend this show" (Scène nationale d'Albi, Scène nationale de Tarbes, Théâtre des 13 Vents – CDN Montpellier, Louvre-Lens, La Manufacture Avignon, Le Cratère – scène nationale d'Alès, Le Phénix – scène nationale Valenciennes, Le Carré – scène nationale Château-Gontier, Scène nationale de Dieppe, Théâtre du Bois de l'Aune...).

In 2022, he created *L'Instant T*, plastic and choreographic performance for public space (L'Atelline, MAIF Social Club Paris, Le Parvis – scène nationale de Tarbes, Scène nationale de Narbonne...)

Its writing being generally inseparable from other scenic elements, publication requires questioning publishing formats: La Vaste Entreprise carries out this work by regularly publishing unique graphic objects.

He also collaborates regularly with other artists: Marion Coutarel, Lonely Circus, Maguelone Vidal.

He also regularly teaches in **art and/or drama schools** (École supérieure d'art de Chalon-sur-Saône, École nationale supérieure d'art dramatique de Montpellier, École supérieure des Beaux Arts de Montpellier, École supérieure des Beaux Arts de Casablanca, FAI-AR – formation supérieure d'art en espace public à Marseille...).
