

MODULE is a Lyon-based producer of monumental installations in public space. Founded by artist-architect Nicolas Paolozzi in 2017, it explores the effects of large-scale architecture animated by light and sound.

Considering space as a set of interactions, Paolozzi designs pieces that evolve through time. MODULE offers a unique, immersive experience of reality through the design of hybrid architectures that blend tangible and intangible materials.

Nicolas Paolozzi began his work in 2011 with RDV Collective, a digital art project that explored the possibilities of image, sound and digital tools in audiovisual installations, stage design and experimental settings. With MODULE he carries this work further, with a concerted focus on the architectural and monumental in all his pieces.

Since 2017, MODULE has been an artist ambassador of Lyon Festival of Lights.

ABYSS is a mysterious creature coming from the depths of the world. Inspired by bioluminescent animals living in the deep ocean, ABYSS aims at raising awareness on the beauty and the fragility of the undersea world The spectator is instantly immersed in its disturbing universe. Its delicate and luminous structure is formed by 4 grand arcs connected in a meticulous network of cables.

Anchored by concrete ballast, the entire installation is held in a state of balance, animated by a strong desire for freedom. Light and sound travel through the massive skeleton, giving life to the strange entity. You can connect with ABYSS through two interfaces at its core, provoking unpredictable reactions from the creature. But watch out — don't disturb it too much...





QUARTZ is a monumental rock made from a set of light sources. The exceptional size renders this enigmatic object visible from a great distance and invites closer inspection. Standing at the foot of the rock, the mineral becomes mystical as visitors are dwarfed by its scale. The meditative feeling is enhanced by a cosmic soundscape that accompanies the installation. Symbolic and essential, QUARTZ integrates subtly into its landscape and enters into an easy dialogue with the surrounding architecture. The verticality of the installation and its wireframe geometry generate an overall feeling of lightness, amplified by the soft character of the object.



KONTAKT is live architecture that combines sound, light and movement. The audience is immersed in a changing tide of atmospheres, carried along by the various moods of the installation. This interactive project allows the public to play at altering certain aspects of its behavior — even to try and tame this changeable creature. The project is both independent and interactive. Even without external intervention it is always evolving, revealing its many faces, one after another. Each mood immerses the viewer in a specific universe.

RESONANCE is an interactive installation which moves to the rhythm of its environment. Dynamic and in constant motion, this massive tunnel recreates the pulse of the city by means of luminous and sonic atmospheres.

Variations of shade and intensity, combined with the movement of lights through the fine metallic structure, create a composition in perpetual evolution




LOTUS is an expanding floral landscape with light and sound creating a poetic wander. The lotus flower life cycle is unlike any other plant: opened in the day, closing for the night and miraculously re-blooming the next morning. In many cultures, this process associates the flower with rebirth and spiritual enlightenment. Inspired by this strong symbolism, LOTUS installation seeks to offer a meditative experience. The installation dimensions reverse the scale: the spectator has the size of an insect when walking in the landscape. This reversal aims at provoking a certain degree of humility towards nature.





HYDRA revisits the symbol of snake through abstract and minimal aesthetics. From Greek mythology to Chinese culture, snakes are in collective imaginaries everywhere in the world. Protective, caring, or daunting, sometimes evil, the mythic animal shows various moods. This interpretation highlights the ambivalence of human perception regarding the snake. Its body fluency provides a sense of enchantment, while its thorny metal framework brings a sense of hostility and fear. Light ux giving movement to the beast increases this double perception. HYDRA body is fully modular, adapting to any given space by modifying the shape of its curves and lines.

TETRA has a kind of mystery presence imposing in space. Made of bars of light, each tetrahedron is an individual entity, reflecting the individualism in our societies. And yet the way they are nested, interlinked, reveals a collaborative world. Its circular pattern advocates for sustainability. The movement of lights along the structure make it seem half machine, half living organism. The installation has a magnetic, almost hypnotic, quality, drawing visitors into a consideration of how we care for this earth.



ORGAN is an instrument that uses the visible spectrum as a musical scale. Interpreting light itself as musical notes, ORGAN aims at involving our visual senses in the way we listen to melody. An interactive terminal set in front of this futuristic instrument enables the visitor to play it, turning them into a musician of light.

ORGAN is a luminous instrument that attracts curiosity and creates a festive atmosphere. Strangely gothic, ORGAN is an artefact straight from a church of the future.

TOTEMS is a playful project reinterpreting signs and signals. Thanks to its height and bright exterior, it can be seen from a great distance. Its triangle shape allows its visual elements to be read from all sides, and makes each Totem a gathering point within public space. Monumental, the installation remains very light and airy due to the sharpness of its structure, and thanks to woven banners that float along with the wind. A modular and repetitive design reinforces the legibility of the project - simple and clear - and stresses verticality in space. First an artistic project, Totem is also a functional tool providing public information.

TOWERS is a project that acts as a signpost and beacon. Its aim was to direct audiences throughout Lyon Festival of Lights, while remaining an artistic installation in its own right. Its great height makes it visible from afar. Visitors first see the dynamic lights, giving almost a oating feeling. Drawing closer, they discover graphic directions and practical information integrated into the artwork. The installation has numerous possible con gurations, making it a unique and striking addition to any event.




Squares is a massive installation giving a subtle depth to the stage. The light running through it gives power and energy to the show.
