As a writer, she has published several works since 2005. For the past 6 years, she has been involved in transmedia projects, NORD SUD, published in 2019, and ARBRES- MONDES produced in 2022. She was laureate of the Villa Formose writing residency in Taiwan in 2023 for the sound work in augmented reality Villes flottantes, and laureate of the Villa Albertine in the USA in 2025. President of the Socotra dragon blood tree association, she wrote a travelogue about Socotra, as part of a residency at the Jan Michalski Foundation in June 2023, and published a book of photographs and poems with Melrakki Editions in December 2023, in collaboration with Benoît Palusinski.

She is currently taking part in the «Les gardiens de l'océan» project with Elsa Mroziewicz and in a sound project based on colors.

She is also president of the association La Plume de Paon, which promotes the development of Frenchlanguage audio books, and founder of the training and consultancy agency NUMERED Conseil, dedicated to cultural professionals faced with digital change. In this capacity, she regularly works for the Institut Français, in France and abroad.

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Elsa MROZIEWICZ

Multidisciplinary visual artist

Elsa co-directed the transmedia project ARBRES-MONDES, shortlisted at the Bologna International Book Fair. Her giant pop-up book enhanced with Baobab was shortlisted for the MEGGENDORFER FOR ARTIST BOOKS 2023 prize (USA) and is exhibited at the Goodplanet Foundation in Paris.

As an illustrator, she has created numerous illustrated books and animated artist's books that have been exhibited in museums, fairs and media libraries, including in New York at Columbia University (Rare Book and Manuscript Library), in Prague at the B1 Centre for contemporary design, and in Italy at Milan Design Week. Elsa has published several children's books with Minedition to enthusiastic acclaim: The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, News & Observers.

She is currently developing augmented sound works with author Cécile Palusinski:

«The Universal Forest» on endangered animals (supported by the Michalski Foundation), «Le sacre des oiseaux» on migratory birds (winner of the Villa Swagatam in India, organized by the French Institute of India and MAD Salon+Lab), and «Villes flottantes», on protecting the oceans and «Ocean guardians» (MR experience).

In 2025, Elsa was awarded the Villa Albertine in the USA for the Floating Cities project.


Invoking a variety of artistic forms (text, sound, music, drawing and animated image), Arbres Mondes (World Trees) takes us on a poetic journey to the heart of the world's forests, extending our reflection on man's relationship with nature through the universal archetype of the structuring tree linking the three components of the Universe: the celestial, terrestrial and subterranean worlds, a concept used by many peoples around the world.

The forest is the boundary between Here and Elsewhere. In its verticality, the tree is in essence the link between earth and sky, embodying the cyclical nature of cosmic evolution.












ARBRES MONDES A collection of *Pages d'Arbres* illustrated poems, published by the Centre de créations pour l'enfance de Tinqueux.



Giant sound pop-up in augmented reality

The baobab, also known as the «palaver tree», has enormous cultural, social and symbolic value. It is the heart of rituals concerning birth and death. It's where people meet, where they listen to the griot... and where the griot, holder of the Word of Life, is buried, as only the trunk of the sacred baobab can channel his power. In fact, the baobab-sepulchre was both a «common grave» and a «place of worship». In the words of African anthropologist Henri Gravrand, «tabernacle of the Logos».

The Giant Augmented Sound Pop-up is a monumental pop-upsculpture that allows viewers equipped with a smartphone or tablet to use a web application to engage augmented-reality animated scenes and revisited tales from West Africa, set to voice and music, like an echo of the griots' voices...

La forêt universelle

Cute or majestic animals, threatened by human activity or climate change. This epinal image gives biodiversity issues a highly emotional connotation. We all feel empathy for these animals, in a world where deforestation has already caused the disappearance of 58% of vertebrate species in 40 years, and wipes out some 13 million hectares of woodland every year.

The aim of «The Universal Forest» is to give a voice to these endangered species, and bring them back to life through an immersive, poetic experience.

In this work, the viewer, equipped with a smartphone or tablet, can use a web application to trigger augmented-reality animated scenes and poetic sound creations.





Villes flottantes

Digital arts

An ever-growing world population, rising sea levels and threats to ecosystems: cities need to find new alternatives.

Against a backdrop of climate migrations, creating new spaces on the oceans to live in permanent floating cities is an idea that has gained ground, moving from «utopian status» to «the study and implementation of concrete projects».

Thinking about floating cities means thinking about new social projects. These new spaces are blank pages, virgin territories for the imagination and renewal of philosophical, architectural and ecological projects... While 72% of the earth is covered by water, the ocean is an ideal place to project these ideas of new worlds.

With our artistic sound work in augmented reality, we offer the general public a poetic and literary vision of these floating cities, while at the same time providing an opportunity to discover solutions to current ecological challenges (scientific, technological, social, political solutions, etc.)

Villes flottantes proposes a new narrative and a new imaginary around the Ocean, allowing us to discover the singularity of the visions of the countries I've crossed, in my travels or successive residencies in Taiwan (Villa Formose), India (Villa Swagatam), Tunisia (with the Alliance française de Bizerte on the occasion of the Forum de la mer), Brazil (at the Centro Cultural Vale Maranhão, with the support of the Institut français and the Consulate General of Recife), the United States (Villa Albertine) and France.



Les gardiens de l'océan

Les gardiens de l'océan (Ocean Guardians) is an immersive project featuring pop-up boards of imaginary floating cities inspired by Brazil and Taiwan (approx. 1.20 m * 1.20 m), set on a bust-height base), with an augmented reality experience (Quest 3-type headset) enabling users to discover the relationship between these inhabitants and the sea, notably through mythological/spiritual entities linked to the ocean.


Pop-up search boards



Cross stories and portraits of real people met on the same street during a month in Cannes on the Croisette. Cannes 08. 09. 2010, silkscreen, handmade print Pop-up book, kraft paper,

box 150 x 200 mm, unfolded 1500 x 1200 mm, 10 copies

Cannes 08.09 is a book sculpture recreating an urban scenographic space, that of the Croisette in Cannes, and presenting portraits of real people met during a month on the spot. The Croisette paper sculpture unfurls along the sea, with a gallery of portraits. The «unfolding» stories tell pieces of life.

The Buddhist temples and landscapes are strongly inspired by the city of Chiang Rai in northern Thailand and the tiger temple in Kanchanaburi.



BIBLIOTHÈQUES VIVANTES (Living libraries) combines virtual reality and literature in a new way, in the form of an immersive experience in a virtual reality library.

The public is invited to wander through a mysterious citadel made up of imaginary libraries, some of which are inspired by writers' worlds, or destroyed libraries. In this temple of the book, they can listen to excerpts of texts performed by professional readers, until they reach the end of their journey, in what turns out to be the Tower of Babel...
