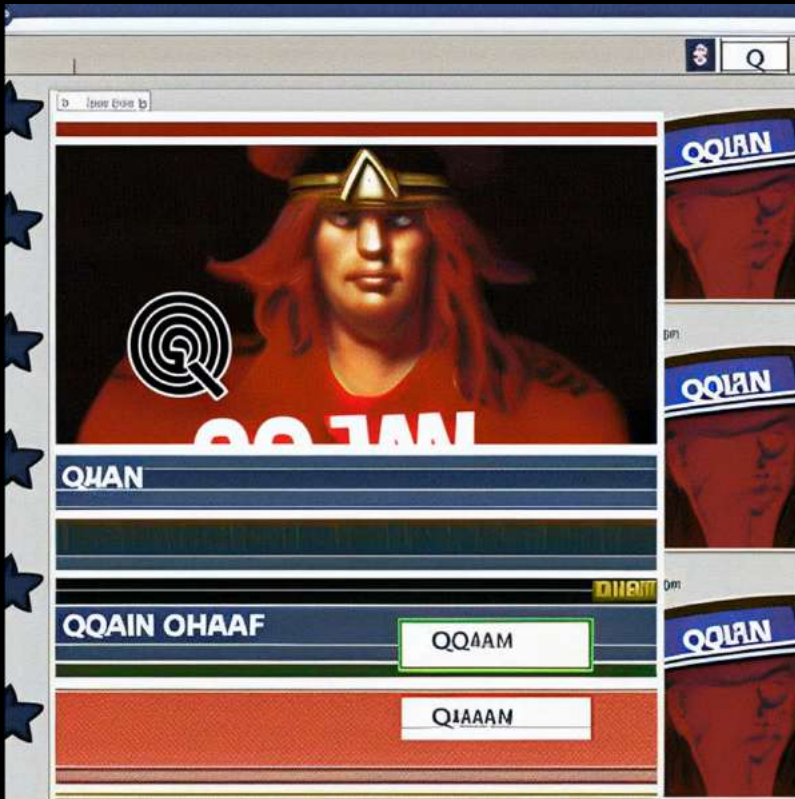
You're Very Special is a documentary exhibition made of a collection of synthetic AI archives of January 6 2021.

This exhibition is a reflective journey through a unique set of video archives—a collection of moments from January 6, 2021, as seen through the lens of artificial intelligence.

Unlike traditional archives, these memories have been reconstructed from the digital echoes of that day. Visitors will step into an experience where the boundary between the screen and reality blurs, **reflecting how we all experienced the Capitol attack accross the real time world wide web: glued to our phones and computers, witnessing history unfold pixel by pixel, second by second.**
